

Finland's NATO-membership April 2023 - NATO's border to Russia doubled - 1.300 km (830 m)

As NATO member, Finland could have nuclear weapons 965 km (600 m) from Kremlin



 NATO HQ to Mikkeli (decision Sept. 2024).
 Ab. 100 km from Russian border

- Under the authority of Nato's Joint Force Command (JFC) in Norfolk, Virginia
- Decision about northern HQ still open
- Training forces of ab. 1000 soldiers would be in Finland from time to time. More in exceptional circumstances

STRATEGIC SIGNALS TO RUSSIA

- February 2022 Finland signed procurement contract for 64 US F-35 fighter jets - 8,378 billion
 € + 2,920 billion € maintenance 2025-2023 – highly underestimated
- US F-35 fighter jets (64) capable of carrying nuclear weapons – to be delivered by 2030 -Rovaniemi (NorthernFinland) - first delivery 2-6 fighters 2026



Denmark has 15 F-35 fighter jets
 March 2025 news: + 8-10 more F-35s

April 2025: Norway now operates 52 F-35s

 March 2025: For the first time as NATO Allies, Danish F-35 and Swedish JAS-39 Gripen fighter jets flew aerial combat training drills in and around Danish airspace Finland has not outspokenly said NO to nukes in the DCA

Finnish president Stubb: It would be acceptable for US nuclear weapons to be transported through Finnish territory

 Sweden: June 2024 - Swedish Prime Minister Ulf Kristersson indicated that he was open to hosting nuclear arms in wartime.

Kristersson, January 2024 - authoritative forum – "Sweden is not at war. But there is no peace either."

 Denmark: Denmark supports the retention and potential use of nuclear weapons on its behalf, by its endorsement of various NATO statements



Norway:

Norway will not permit the stockpiling of nuclear weapons, landmines, or cluster munitions in its territory.

"The parliament asks the government to enter into a dialogue with Denmark, Finland, and Sweden to define a shared view on the storage of nuclear weapons in our areas, as well as establish control mechanisms to ensure compliance with this view."

- Kiruna: DCA US military base







Kaliningrad and St.Petersburg isolated in the Baltic Sea – NATO lake





What kind of allies? September 2022 - Note Nord Stream on the map!




- Regarding the Nord Stream pipelines,
